EPISODE 1: "HOMECOMING"

Juno's family arrives in Johannesburg, is greeted by her grandfather, and drawn into the plan to uncover the mysterious Spear of Destiny. Unbeknownst to them, ominous figures trail their every move.

In the subsequent days, we meet Juno's best friend, Kali, as well as the enigmatic benefactor of their venture—a man whom Juno instinctively mistrusts.

With the aim of exploration, Juno and her friends venture into the bush, where they encounter a group of poachers, which they valiantly attempt to thwart. As a result, the young adventurers become entwined in a whirlwind of escapades where they are separated, facing explosive encounters, a stolen airplane, the unmasking of a villain, and a fearsome lion revealed to be an ally. Amidst the chaos, the trio begins to unravel a sinister, world-threatening conspiracy that extends far beyond the actions of mere poachers.



EPISODE BREAKDOWN

EP 2: "THE GREAT ESCAPE"

We delve into the origins of Juno's bond with Indiana. As poaching surges, Juno, Kali, and Eddie are abducted and taken to a secluded base. Aided by Indiana, the children manage to flee their captors. Juno's parents discover a map to the Spear and leave it for Juno just before their mysterious disappearance.

EP 3: "UPS AND DOWNS"

The story begins with a breathtaking hot-air balloon chase featuring grappling hooks, machine guns, and a fighter plane. The gang leader befriends Juno and offers assistance. Upon learning of her parents' abduction, Juno and her friends locate Longinus' tomb and navigate three booby traps to gain entry.

EP 4: "THE BALANCE"

"The Balance," an enigmatic society, relentlessly pursues the young adventurers through Johannesburg. The true power of the Spear of Destiny is unveiled when Eddie stumbles upon a secret gathering of malevolent world leaders. Juno resolves to save her parents by allying with a South African swindler, a man who despises her family but recognizes the potential for profit.



EPISODE BREAKDOWN

EP 5: "THE SPEAR OF DESTINY"

Juno, her friends, and the swindler traverse a war-ravaged land fraught with danger. They rescue a family from a village besieged by child soldiers. Juno's captive parents are thwarted in their escape attempt, prompting the children to use The Balance as leverage for their rescue. Kali's life hangs in the balance, but Eddie heroically sacrifices himself to save her, becoming a prisoner with Juno's parents.

EP 6: "MIRACLES"

Eddie stages his own daring escape. Vogel captures Juno and Kali, seizing The Balance, which grants the power to control others. He forces Juno to strike Kali against her will. Just when all seems lost, Eddie, presumed dead, resurfaces and liberates the captives with surprising ease, having overheard fragments of their captors' plans. The group travels to Egypt, where they confront an Aryan army led by none other than Hitler himself. Empowered by the Spear's supernatural properties, the elderly dictator has survived the ages. As Hitler unites the Spearhead with The Balance, he gains the ability to manipulate the puppet leaders he has strategically placed in power across the globe. In a climactic showdown, Juno valiantly attempts to stop him but is impaled by the Spear. Her selfless act shifts the balance of power from destruction to salvation, reducing Hitler to ashes.
